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# MATHEMATICAL AND STATISTICAL STUDY OF STUDENT'S CHOICES ON GETTING ADMISSION IN AN INSTITUTE


In the category of boys, in first question 300 boys chosen (b) and 160 boys chosen (c) option. It means majority of boy's student prefer a goodfaculty. In second question 10 boys chosen (a) 440 boys chosen (b) and 10 boys have chosen (c) option and option (d) was not a preference of any student. It means almost all students want to choose a subject which is of their interest. In third question 450 boys chosen (a) and 10 boys chosen (c) option. The students want freedom to adopt any subject with any discipline. In fourth question 260 boys went with (a), 40 boys were agree with (b), 70 boys liked option (c) and 90 boys tagged with option (d). They give preference the same pattern which is going on. In fifth question 140 boys like option (a), 230 boys liked option (b) and 90 boys went with option (c). More of the students feel no need to make compulsory N.C.C./ N.S.S. /SCOUT. etc.. For sixth question, 450 boys prefer to go with option (a) while only 10 boys preferred to go with option (c). Almost all students feel extra cocurriculum activities is necessary in the institutions. In seventh question, 440 boys feel happy to select option (a) while 10 were satisfied with option (b) and (20) were happy with option (c). Similar the sixth question all students feel the student union election must be held. For eighth question, 200 boys selected option (a), 180 boys selected option (c) and 70 went for option


(d). For more of the students sports complex is their preferable place to pass time. In ninth question, 300 boys tick for option (a), 100 tick for option (b) while 60 liked option (c). Majority of students go for compulsory of uniform they feel uniform should be in the institution. For tenth question, 50 boys went for option (a) and 400 boys preferred option (b). Students feel


institutions should be separate for girls and boys. For eleventh question, 240 boys opted answer as (a), 100boys chosen answer as (b) and 110 went for answer (c). Boys feel syllabus should be mixed between basic and professional studies.

In the category of girls, in first question 160 girls chosen (b) and 20 girls chosen (c) option. It means almost all girls student prefer a good faculty. In second question 10 girls chosen (a) 170 girls chosen (b) while option (c) and option (d) ware not a preference of any student. It means almost all students want to choose a subject which is of their interest. In third question all 180 girls chosen (a). The girl students want freedom to adopt any subject with any discipline. In fourth question 80 girls went with (a), 80 girls were agree with (b), 10 girls liked option (c) and 10 girls tagged with option (d). They give preference the same pattern which is going on. In fifth question 110 girls like option (a), 70 girls liked option (b) and no onegirls went with option (c).

Most of the girl students feel no need to make compulsory N.C.C./ N.S.S. /SCOUT etc.. For sixth question, all 180 girls prefer to go with option (a).Almost all students feel extra co-curriculum activities is necessary in the institutions. The same in seventh question, all 180 girls feel happy to select option (a). Similar the sixth question all students feel the student union election must be held. For eighth question, 180 girls selected option (a), 180 girls selected option (c) and 20 went for option (d). Almost all of the students sports complex is their preferable place to pass time. In ninth question, 140 girls tick for option (a), 10 tick for option (b) while 30 liked option (c). Majority of the girl students go for compulsory of uniform they feel uniform should be in the institution. For tenth question, 50 girls went for option (a) and 140 girls preferred option (b). Girl students feel institutions should be separate for girls and boys. For eleventh question, 60 girls opted answer as (a), 130 girls chosen answer as (c) and no one opted answer as (b). Girls feel syllabus should be mixed between basic and professional studies.

The authors feel that their study will help to understand the psychology and choices of students. It will very helpful for education sector because they can made the sufficient changes according to preference of students. This study will also helpful to provide better knowledge environment and job seeking environment for students.

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
